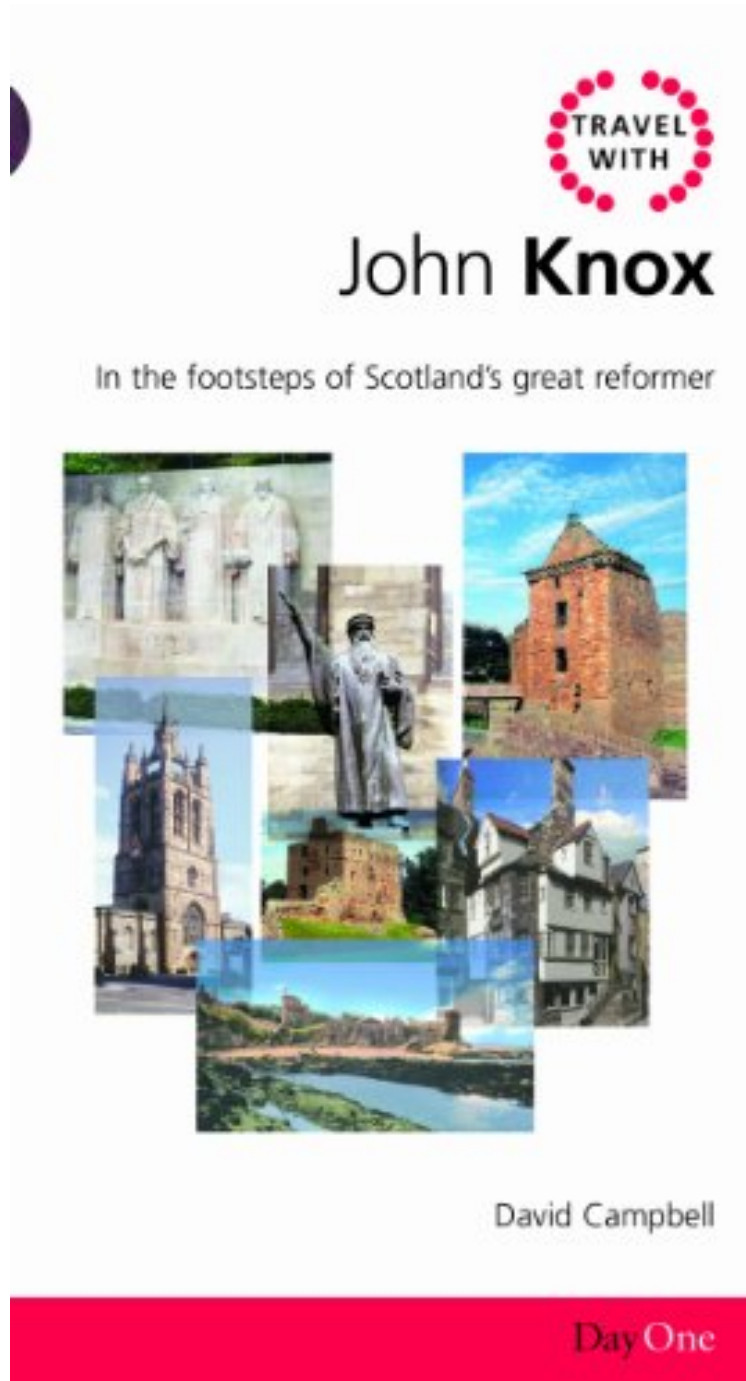

As a travel book, the book is a bit thin, but as a concise historical biography, it's excellent. They are very fair to Knox, without being starry-eyed. And putting in all the travel details, (including beautiful pictures), does give it a bit of an edge. One interesting thing that struck me while reading it was that when Knox was in Geneva, the liturgy he used was a very simple one that included a question and discussion time. Maybe we need to re-think our ideas about what constitutes historic Presbyterian worship!
