A useful resource By Max This atlas complements those I have for "Eastern Europe" and "Russia" (which covers Russia pre-revolution, the USSR, and post USSR) which I desired owing to some concentrated reading concerning Ukraine. The atlas is ok for these purposes, but the period it covers does not include Ukraine's independence, published by the University of Toronto Press in 1985. Except for that it is extremely valuable for those with a strong interest in Ukraine and what we in the west have referred to as "Eastern" or "Middle Europe," T. , particularly owing to the texts which accompany each map. The period covered is from about 250-800 AD through the post-WWII, but ceases there. The texts associated with each map cover a lot of material, enough to keep anyone busy if one follows along.
