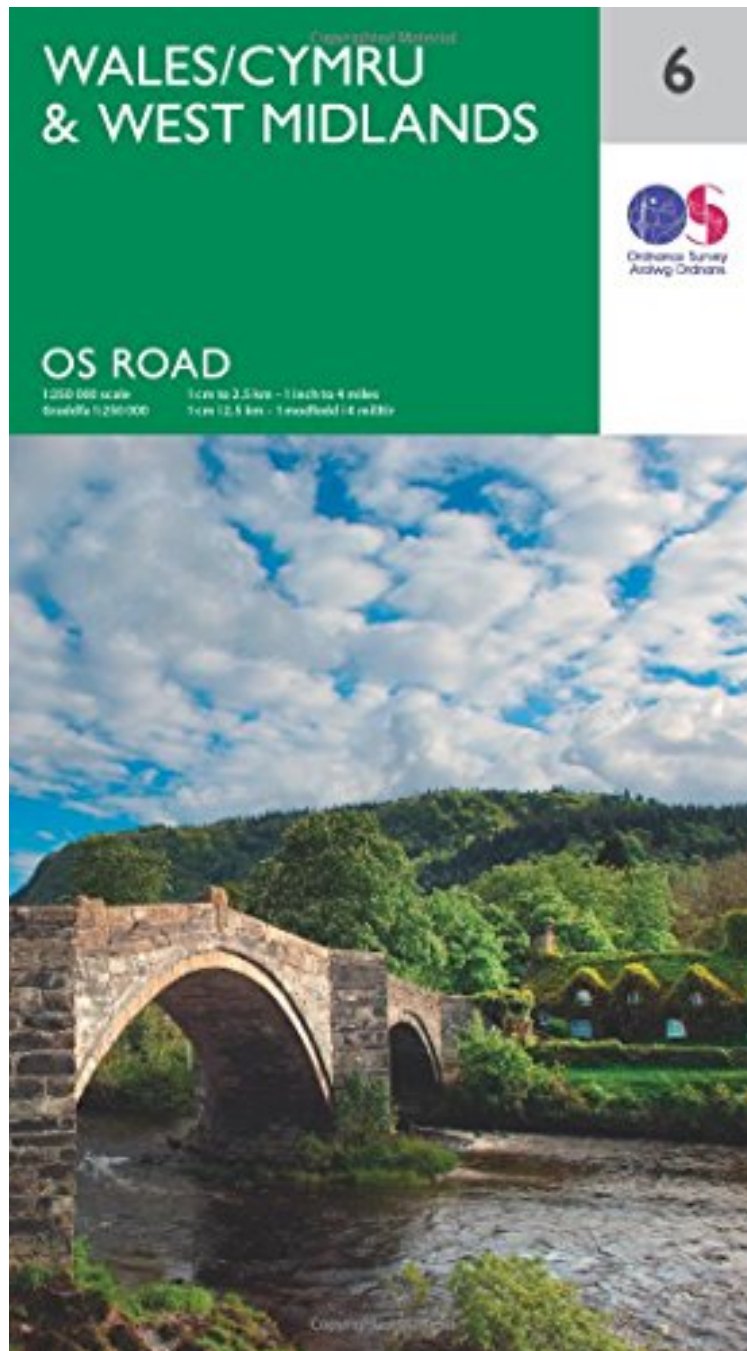

This Ordnance Survey Road Travel Map covers Wales and the West Midlands of Great Britain at a 1:250,000 (1 inch to 4 miles) scale, matching the major and mid-grade road network with a clear color depiction of the physical scale of the terrain. Ordnance Survey maps are the last word in cartography for Britain This edition will allow the traveler to navigate the road networks in Wales and a swath of the Midlands as far north and east as Sheffield and as far South and East as Swindon. Although at the wrong scale for hiking or other off-road activities, the detail is sufficient to locate parks, such as the Peak District, and some prominent tourist locations, such as Chatsworth House. The map information is printed in English and Welsh, with a grid system for location and a additional chart for distances between major cities. This is the best map of Wales currently available. Not only does it contain extremely detailed road depictions, but also has useful distance information, a table of restricted motorway junctions, a geographical relief map, and depictions of numerous points of interest. I was interested in a detailed map of the Snowdonia region, and in particular for coverage of Portmeirion, Porthmadog, Llanfihangel-y-Traethau, Penrhyndeudraeth, and Ffridd Uchaf. All this and more was well detailed, making for easy route planning. I heartily recommend this map for anyone contemplating a trip to Wales, particularly Northern Wales.

The OS Roadmaps series are single sided folded maps, the 8 maps provide GB 1: 250 000 coverage to enable the end user to navigate and plan their road journey. The maps include all motorways, primary routes and A roads plus detailed tourist information including National Parks, Country Parks and World Heritage sites and a useful town and city gazetteer. The eight maps in the series are Northern Scotland, Orkney Shetland, Western Scotland and the Western Isles, Southern Scotland and Northumberland, Northern England, East Midlands and East Anglia, Wales/Cymru and West Midlands, South West England and South East England.
